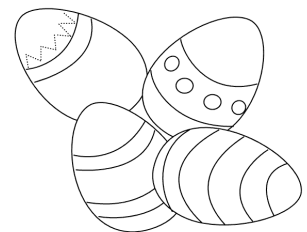
EASTER CRAFT AFTERNOON
